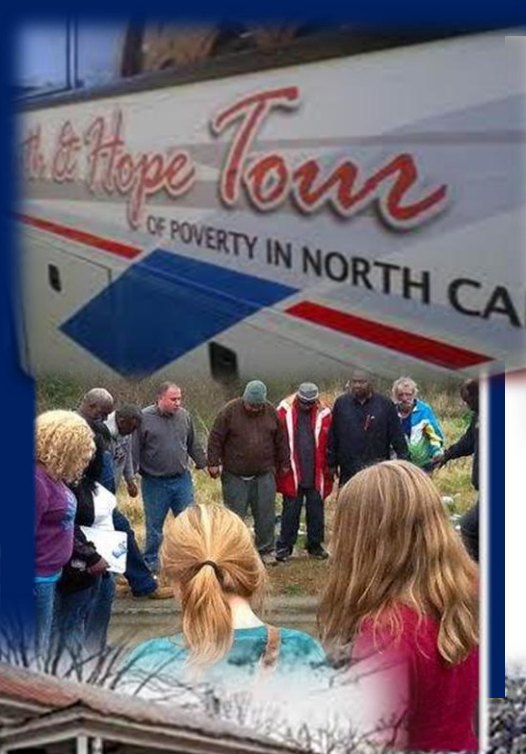


7th Historic Thousands on Jones Street People's Assembly Coalition Mass Mobilization
