Each state along the route has an issue focus from the national advocacy agenda. As North Carolina has emerged as the "national battleground for voting rights," the **North Carolina leg of the march will concentrate on voting rights.**

North Carolina will pick up the AJ4J baton on August 29 through September 7.

Supporters from around the state and nation, including National NAACP President and CEO Cornell W. Brooks, will cross over from South Carolina into Richmond County, North Carolina August 29 and march through the state, exiting through Warren County into Virginia on September 8. Marchers will continue onward to Washington, D.C., planning to arrive on September 15.
