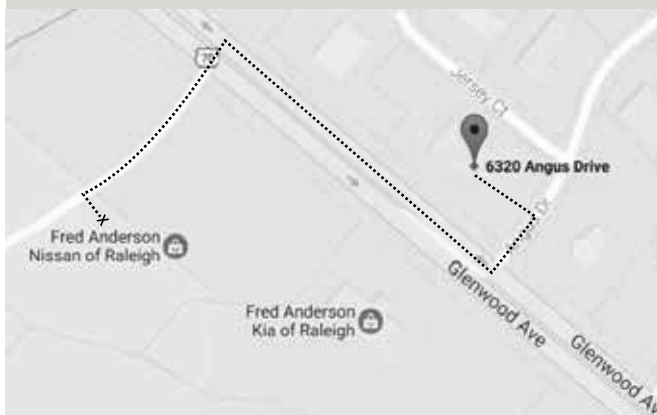
## WORKERS' RIGHTS ARE CIVIL RIGHTS

5,000 workers, 80% of them African-American, are organizing a union at the Nissan car plant in Canton, Mississippi.

They experience dangerous working conditions, bullying by management, unfair treatment of temp workers, line speed ups, and long hours. And when workers began organizing their union, Nissan unlawfully interrogated employees, threatened workers with termination for union activity and said the plant would close if the workers unionize.

Join us and make a difference—in Mississippi and in our community—by standing with the Nissan workers organizing for a voice on the job.
