Mark Your Calendars – the 2015 session of Carolina Labor School will be held at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington from Sunday, July 19 to Friday, July 24.



- ★ On-site registration at 5:00 PM on Sunday, July 19. Orientation begins at 7:00 PM.
- ★ Class begins at 9:00 AM on Monday, July 20 and ends before noon on Friday, July 24.



Registration – students can stay on campus or commute to campus every day; in either case, tuition & fees covers instruction, materials, admission to Game Day & Picnic, all meals for on-campus students and lunch daily for commuters. **Take 20% off tuition & fees for students age 28 and younger!**

- On Campus:** \$385 tuition & fees per student; includes lodging, three meals a day.
- Commuters:** \$285 tuition & fees per student; breakfast & dinner are not included.
- AFL-CIO T-Shirt:** \$15 more buys one of our 100% USA union-made & printed slogan tees: *“What’s good for WORKERS is good for you and me!”*



Deadlines – the cutoff date for registration is **Friday, June 26, 2015**. Tuition & fees may be paid upon arrival (if necessary), but **registration forms must be submitted by the cutoff date to reserve space.**
